This year's scholarship theme, Igniting the Spark, allows high school students in the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area to enact lasting change in their communities. Over the years, our student-organized scholarship has allowed high school students to act on their ideas. This year, the first-place winner will execute his or her idea through a seven-week internship with AASuccess, as well as receive a \$3,000 cash prize.

Our theme, Igniting the Spark, is meant to create a spark of aspiration to leave an impact on the community around you. For our applicants this year, this theme means creating a project that will not only provide benefits in the short-term, but will also be a sustainable source for change within a community.

Aspiration can come in many forms, in both tangible and emotional ways. Some projects may be able to remain viable in a community long after its duration, continuously providing resources and aid to those
