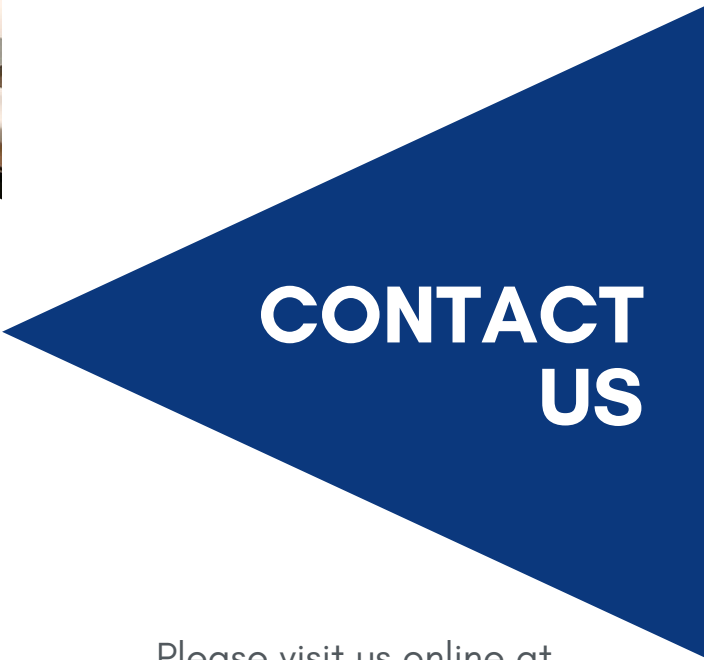

LIFE SKILLS ACADEMY

AASuccess offers young students and professionals year round mentorship on leadership and professional skills, while providing resources and guidance to help them turn their community giving back ideas into reality. We create a safe environment where students can challenge themselves without the fear of failure.

Level 1

Students focus on discipline and ability to follow through with basic tasks. Basic core values such as Integrity and Empathy are cultivated. Be able to articulate their thoughts effectively.

Level 2

Students demonstrate the ability to follow through with their 3-month plan, advanced task management, optimize work, school, & personal wellness, and be able to work well with others.

Level 3

Students are expected to become a mentor, while involved in the management team of AASuccess. They become a leader at school or in their professional career while continuing to give back.

Level 4

Students become leaders, influencing others and making positive changes in their workplace and community.
